in 2015, an increase of 11% over 2014, resulting in **295 FATALITIES**.

Getting less than 5 hours of sleep in a night can lead to a 4x higher crash risk. *SOURCE: AAA*

DRIVERS should...

- ✓ Get enough sleep before driving and take plenty of breaks to refresh. Following the HOS requirements is not enough!
- ✓ Manage your customers' expectations about the schedule. Don't be pressured to skip rest.
- ✓ Check to see if your meds could be making you sleepy.

OPERATORS should...

- ✓ Implement a fatigue management program based on the North American Fatigue Management Program.
- ✓ Install collision avoidance technologies to mitigate and prevent crashes.
