Jeff,

I wanted to bring you up to date as to where we are as a manufacturer and our investment in HEMS safety equipment and services. We have completed the Voice & Video Recorder and are moving rapidly to integrating primary flight data and live parameter exceedance alerts over the satellite network. Here is a link to a short demo of the OVVR playback <http://www.outerlink.com/training.php>  
The audio is not playing on the demo but is part of the standard system.

The flight data (P,R,Y, AS, G force, VS, etc) will be integrated with RadAlt data and during the recording process a customer driven threshold matrix will drive live exceedance messages of varying severity over the satellite network. G force data will allow us to automatically drive Mayday activation without the need for pilot input.

We have committed a great deal of our resources to the HEMS safety issue and will be attending the hearings in early February. Our interest is to validate our product and service path and to learn how we can tailor our systems to provide a direct and immediate impact on safety. If you feel our involvement at the hearings can be of any benefit to the NTSB we would gladly participate as you so direct.
