I spoke with LCDR Clare, Chief of Prevention at CG Sector Juneau this morning. The 3rd mate voluntarily surrendered his license immediately following the grounding. He received a 4 month license suspension, along with the requirement to take a Bridge Resource Management course at his own expense. He has completed his obligations, and he now has his license back.

Negotiations continue with the master as to his license status, with a determination and resolution expected very shortly. It will probably result in some period of suspension to his license. At this point though, where no action has been taken against it, he still is in possession of a current, valid license.

Additionally, both the master and the 3rd mate were terminated by the company following the grounding. Guess you knew that, but just throwing it in just in case you didn't.
