**ORDER GRANTING STAY**

Respondent, by counsel, has requested a stay of NTSB Order EA-3698 (served October 27, 1992), recons. denied, NTSB Order EA-3788 (served February 4, 1993), pending disposition of a petition for review of that order which he states he has filed in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia.<sup>1</sup> No opposition to the request has been received.

It appears that good cause exists for granting the stay.
