ORDER GRANTING STAY

Respondent by counsel has requested a stay of NTSB Order EA-4607, served November 21, 1997, pending disposition of a petition for review of that order¹ to be filed in the United States Court of Appeals pursuant to Section 1006 of the Federal Aviation Act (49 U.S.C. 46110) and the NTSB Rules (49 C.F.R. 821.64).² It appears that good cause exists for granting the stay.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of NTSB Order EA-4607 is stayed until the expiration of the 60-day period within which a petition for review may be filed with the Court of Appeals; however, if such a petition is filed, the stay will continue in effect until the court enters judgment on the petition.
