**ORDER GRANTING STAY**

Respondent has requested a stay of NTSB Order EA-4695, served August 31, 1998, pending disposition of his appeal of that decision to the United States Court of Appeals for the 10<sup>th</sup> Circuit.<sup>1</sup> No opposition to the request has been received. It appears that good cause exists for granting the stay.

**ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

The effective date of NTSB Order EA-4695 is stayed until the expiration of the 60-day period within which a petition for review may be filed with the Court of Appeals; however, if such a petition is filed, the stay will continue in effect until the court enters judgment on the petition.

<sup>1</sup> In EA-4695 we affirmed the Administrator's order, alleging a violation of FAR § 61.15 and suspending respondent's airline transport pilot certificate for 45 days, as a result of respondent's failure to timely report to the FAA the revocation of his driver's license and subsequent conviction for driving under the influence of alcohol.
