ORDER GRANTING STAY

Respondent has requested a stay of NTSB Order No. EA-5448, served May 6, 2009, pending disposition of a petition for review of that order in the United States Court of Appeals pursuant to Section 1006 of the Federal Aviation Act (49 U.S.C. § 14110) and the Board's Rules of Practice (49 C.F.R. § 821.64).¹ The Administrator does not oppose respondent's request. It appears that good cause exists for granting the stay.

¹ In NTSB Order No. EA-5448, the law judge granted the Administrator's motion for summary judgment, thereby denying respondent's appeal of the Administrator's suspension order which alleged that respondent had violated certain provisions of the Federal Aviation Regulations and ordered suspension of respondent's private pilot certificate for a 30-day period.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of NTSB Order No. EA-5448 is stayed until the expiration of the 60-day period within which a petition for review may be filed with the Court of Appeals; however, if such a petition is filed, the stay will continue in effect until the court enters judgment on the petition.
