**ORDER**

Respondent and the Administrator filed a joint motion to vacate the oral initial decision of the law judge because the parties have reached a settlement agreement. As part of this joint motion, both parties agreed to withdraw their respective appeals with prejudice and the Administrator agreed to withdraw his complaint with prejudice.

**ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Respondent's motion to withdraw his appeal is granted;
2. The Administrator's motion to withdraw the FAA's appeal

is granted;

3. The joint motion of respondent and the Administrator to vacate the law judge's decision is granted;

4. The July 29, 2010 oral initial decision of the law judge is vacated; and

5. Respondent's appeal and the Administrator's appeal are dismissed.<sup>1</sup>
