**ORDER GRANTING STAY**

Respondent, by counsel, has requested a stay of NTSB Order EA-3592 (served June 24, 1992) pending disposition of a petition for review of that order to be filed in the U.S. Court of Appeals.<sup>1</sup> No opposition to the request has been received.

It appears that good cause exists for granting the stay.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of Order EA-3592 is stayed until August 23, 1992, which marks the expiration of the 60-day period within which a petition for review may be filed with the Court of Appeals. If such a petition is filed, the stay will continue in effect until the Court enters judgment on the petition.
