ORDER GRANTING STAY


Respondent, through counsel, has requested the Board to stay, pending judicial appeal, Order EA-3716 (served November 16 1992), in which the Board affirmed a 30-day suspension of respondent's airline transport pilot certificate. Respondent has filed a timely petition for review of the order in the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.

According to respondent, the Administrator does not oppose a stay of the order.

It appears that good cause exists for granting the request.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of Order EA-3716 is stayed. The stay will continue in effect until the Court enters judgment on the petition.
