**ORDER GRANTING STAY**

Respondent, through a representative, has requested a stay of NTSB Order EA-3947 (served August 6, 1993) pending disposition of a petition for review of that order to be filed in the U.S. Court of Appeals.<sup>1</sup> No opposition to the request has been received.

<sup>1</sup>The Board in Order EA-3947 affirmed a 30-day suspension of the airframe rating of respondent's mechanic certificate. Reconsideration of that order was denied in Board Order EA-4007 (served November 5, 1993).

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of Order EA-3947 is stayed until January 4, 1994, which marks the expiration of the 60-day period within which a petition for review may be filed with the Court of Appeals. If such a petition is filed, the stay will continue in effect until the Court enters judgment on the petition.
