ORDER GRANTING STAY

Respondent has requested a stay of NTSB Order No. EA-4034 (served December 10, 1993) pending disposition of a petition for review of that order which respondent has filed in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit.¹ The Administrator has not filed an answer to the application for a stay.

It appears that good cause exists for granting the stay.

¹In NTSB Order No. EA-4034, the Board affirmed an order of the law judge that had dismissed as untimely an appeal the respondent had taken from an order of the Administrator suspending his mechanic certificate for 90 days for his alleged violation of section 43.15(a)(1) of the Federal Aviation Regulations, 14 CFR Part 43.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of NTSB Order No. EA-4034 is stayed until the Court of Appeals enters judgment on respondent's petition for review.
