**ORDER GRANTING STAY**

Respondent has requested a stay of NTSB Orders EA-4686 and 4616, served August 13, 1998, and January 22, 1998, pending disposition of a petition for review of those orders stated to have been filed concurrently in the U.S. Court of Appeals.<sup>1</sup> No opposition to the request has been received. It appears that good cause exists for granting the stay.

**ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

The effective date of NTSB Orders EA-4686 and 4616 is stayed until the expiration of the 60-day period within which a petition for review may be filed with the Court of Appeals; however, if such a petition is filed, the stay will continue in effect until the court enters judgment on the petition.

<sup>1</sup> In EA-4616, the Board affirmed a 100-day suspension of respondent's airman certificate for acting as pilot-in-command of a passenger-carrying flight without the proper authorization. In EA-4686, the Board denied respondent's petition for reconsideration.
