ORDER GRANTING STAY

Respondent has requested a stay of NTSB Order No. EA-5468, served August 5, 2009, pending disposition of a petition for review of that order in the United States Court of Appeals, pursuant to Section 1006 of the Federal Aviation Act (codified at 49 U.S.C. § 46110) and the Board's Rules of Practice. See 49 C.F.R. § 821.64.¹ The Administrator does not oppose respondent's request. We find that good cause exists for granting the stay.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of NTSB Order No. EA-5468 is stayed until the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit enters judgment on respondent's August 13, 2009 petition for review.
