ORDER GRANTING STAY

Respondent has requested a stay of NTSB Order No. EA-5485, served October 21, 2009, pending disposition of a petition for review of that order in the United States Court of Appeals, pursuant to Section 1006 of the Federal Aviation Act (codified at 49 U.S.C. § 46110) and the Board's Rules of Practice. See 49 C.F.R. § 821.64.¹ The Administrator does not oppose respondent's request. We find that good cause exists for granting the stay.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of NTSB Order No. EA-5485 is stayed until the expiration of the 60-day period within which a petition for review may be filed with the court of appeals; however, if such a petition is filed, the stay will continue in effect until the court enters judgment on the petition.
