ORDER GRANTING STAY

Respondent has requested a stay of NTSB Order No. EA-5521, served June 3, 2010, pending disposition of a petition for review of that order in the United States Court of Appeals, pursuant to Section 1006 of the Federal Aviation Act (codified at 49 U.S.C. § 46110) and the Board's Rules of Practice. See 49 C.F.R. § 821.64.¹ The Administrator does not oppose respondent's request. We find that good cause exists for granting the stay.

¹ NTSB Order No. EA-5521 concluded that respondent had violated certain provisions of the Federal Aviation Regulations and ordered suspension of respondent's commercial pilot certificate for a 45-day period.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of NTSB Order No. EA-5521 is stayed until the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit enters judgment on respondent's July 1, 2010 petition for review.
