ORDER DISMISSING PETITION

Petitioner, who proceeds *pro se*, has filed a timely petition for reconsideration of NTSB Order No. EA-5622, wherein the Board denied petitioner’s appeal under the doctrine of *res judicata*. This petition, dated April 18, 2012, presents the same arguments we considered and rejected on review of petitioner’s appeal.
