# Goals of the Miramar Air Show



1. To support recruitment efforts for all military services.

- Layout of Ramp







# Emergency Response Plans

- S-3 Operations hosted a Table Top Exercise on Tuesday 30 Aug 2011 designed to promote staff coordination following a terrorist attack at the MCAS Miramar Air Show.
- This exercise will refine execution of the response effort and the decision making process as well as to demonstrate the importance of inter-agency cooperation with the local community and public safety agencies.
- NOTE: HQMC Contractor CRA is providing support, and we also have representatives from local government and law enforcement attending the TTX.
- Participants: Dept Heads and/or Deputies, plus key staff/billet holders during the Air Show (SNCO or above).
- Request representatives from S-3/AirOps, S-4 , S-6, S-7, S-8, PMO, Fire, ARFF, EOD, PAO, MED, MCCA, SJA, Safety and the EOC (1 ea).
