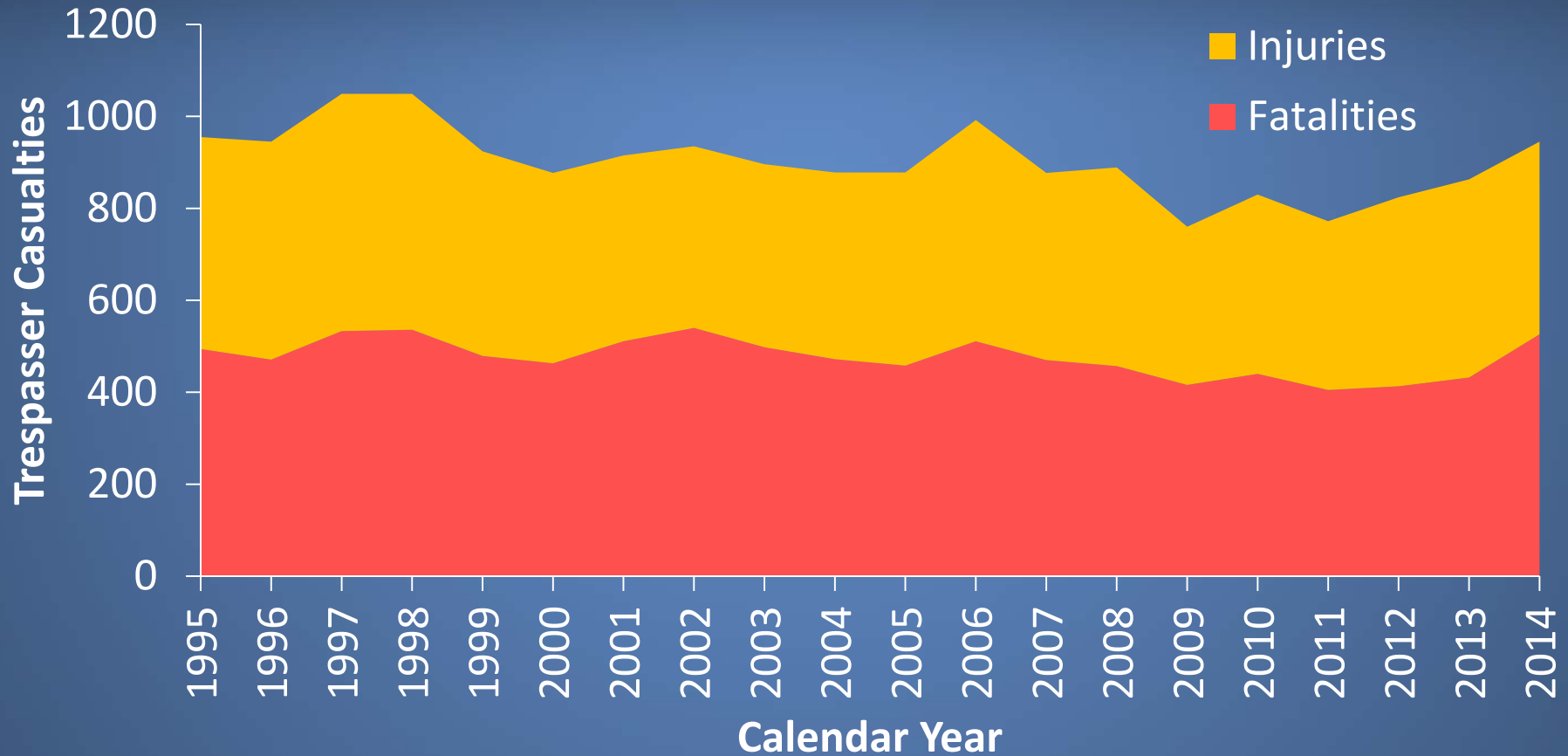
1978 NTSB Letter to FRA

- Noted that nearly 500 pedestrians killed annually
- Analyzed characteristics of fatal accidents
 - Trespasser demographics
 - Weather and track conditions
- Recommended that FRA develop criteria for fencing tracks

Recent Accident Investigations

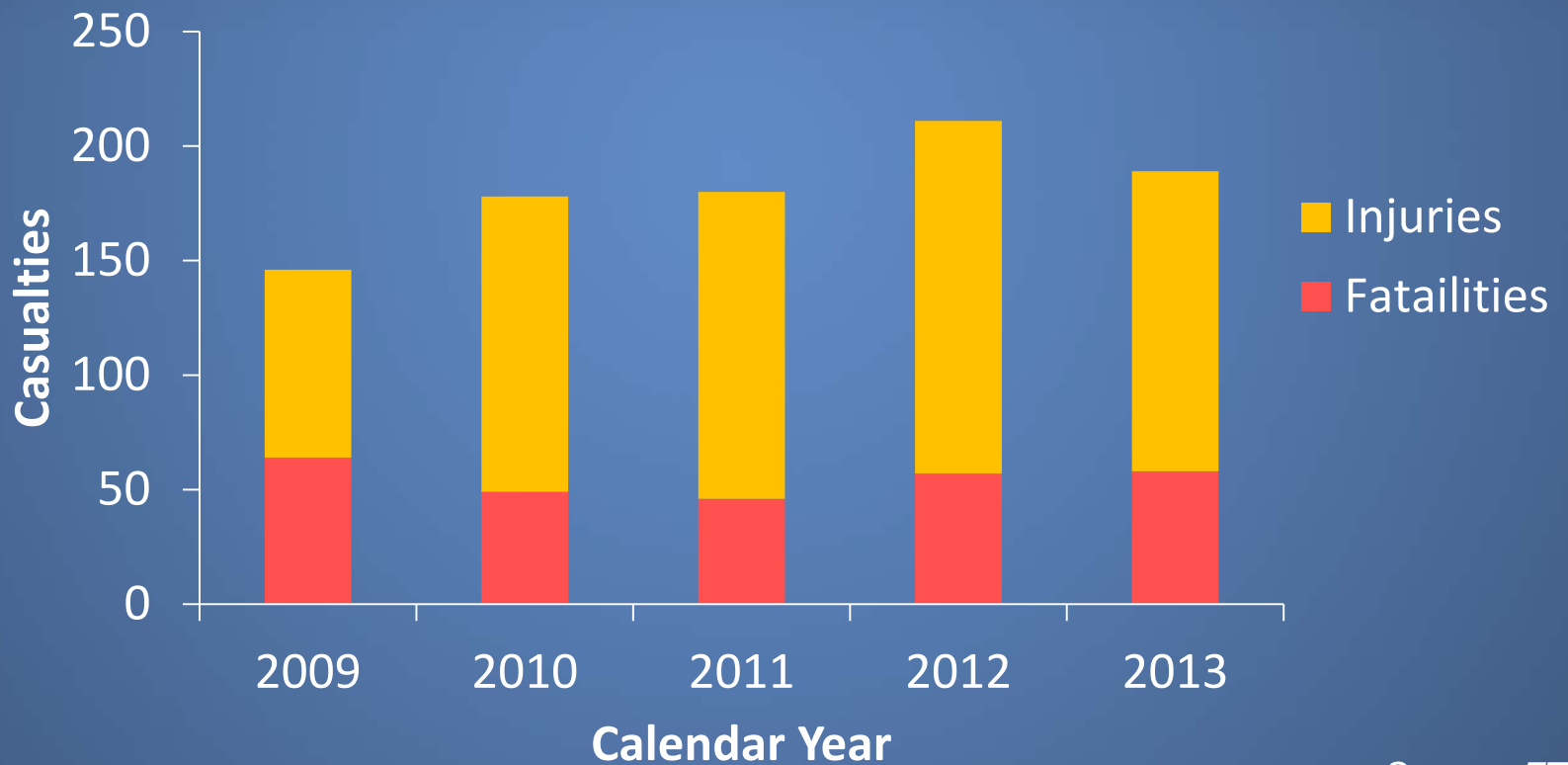
- February 20, 2014: Jesup, GA
 - Film crew on railroad bridge
 - Freight train struck movie prop
 - 1 person killed, 6 injured
- August 20, 2012: Ellicott City, MD
 - Coal train derailed 21 cars while crossing railroad bridge
 - 2 people sitting on bridge killed by spilled coal
