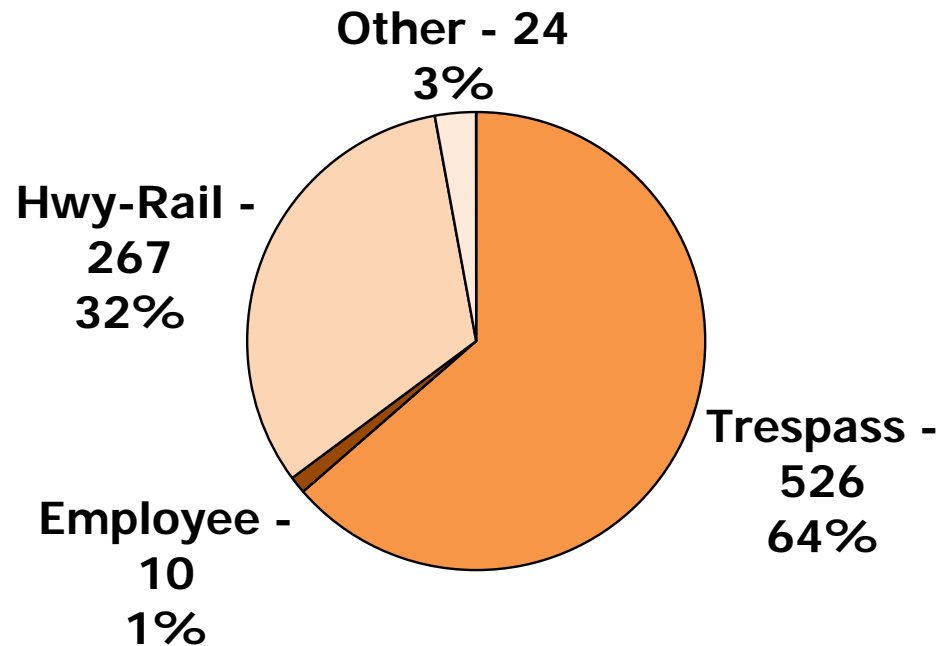

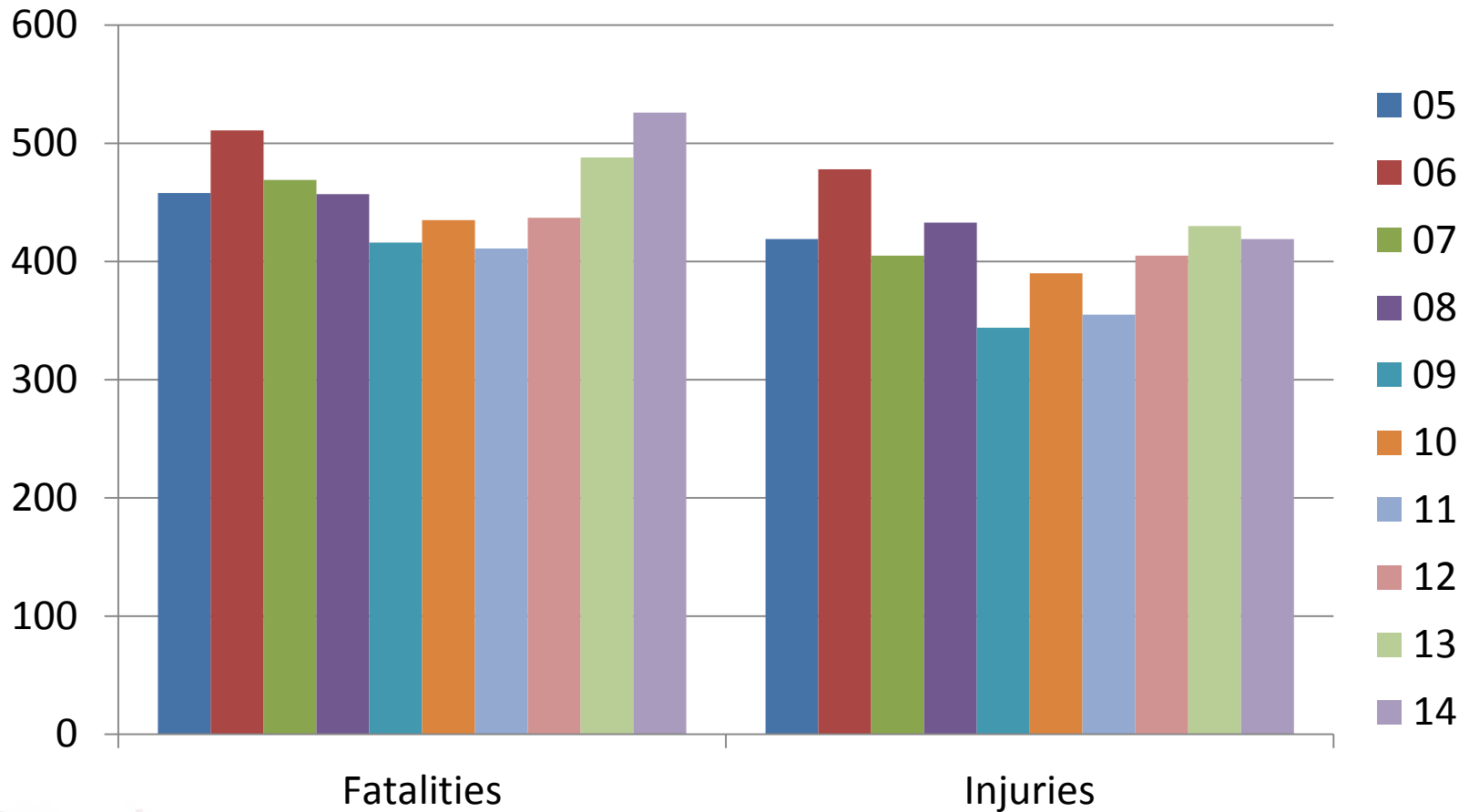

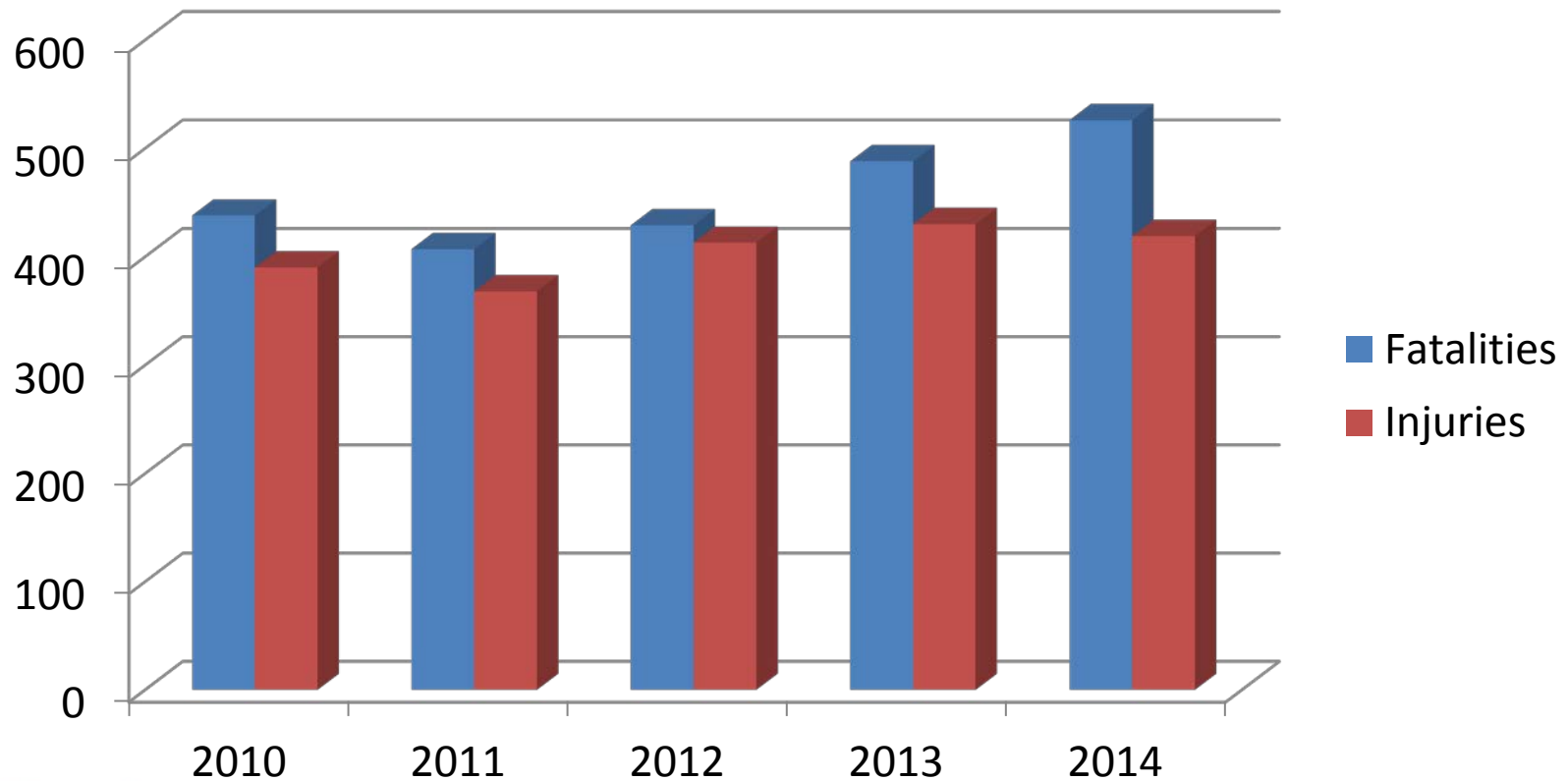

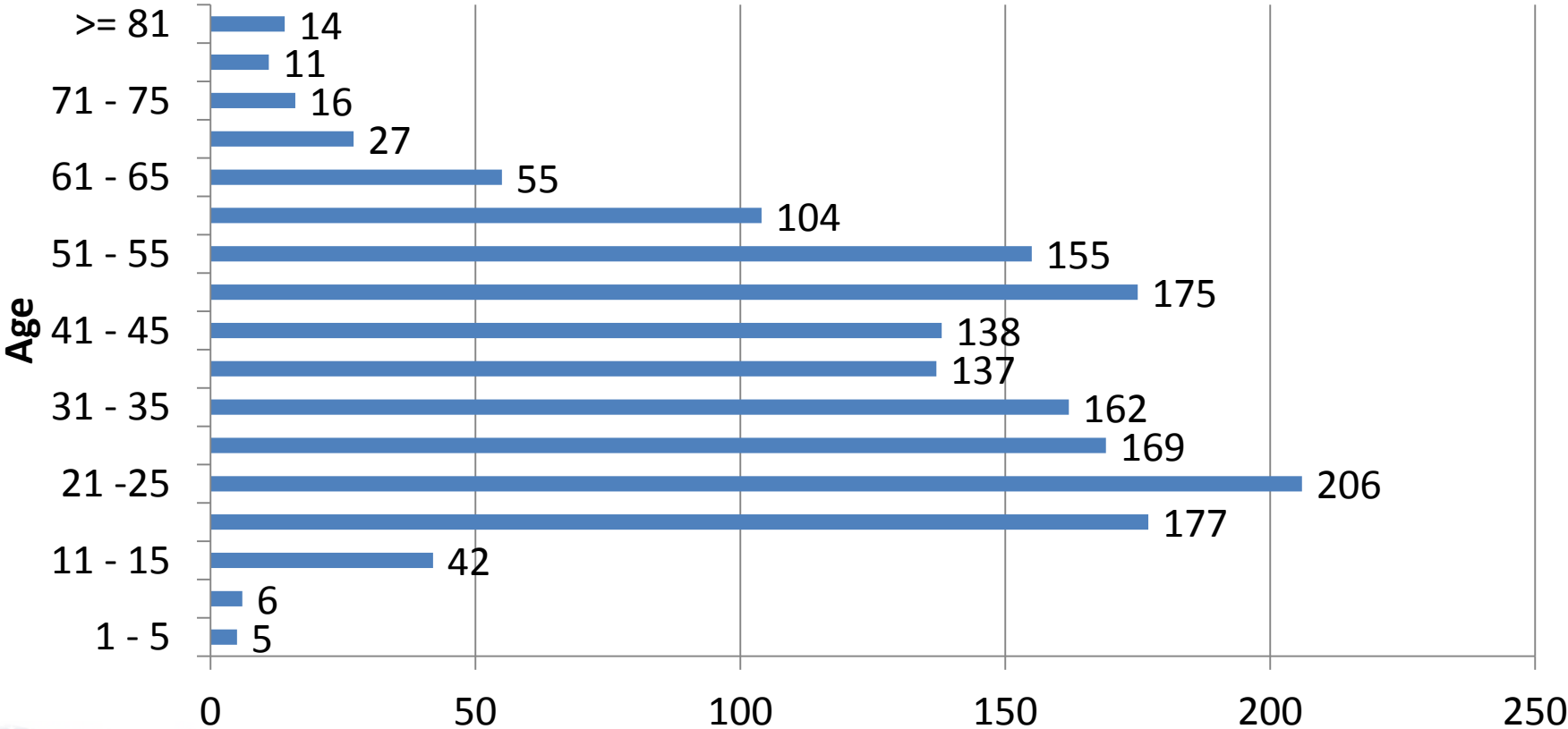

Trespass Fatalities by Age 2011 – 2014



Trespasser Casualties Events 2011 - 2014

- 3,404 total events
- 2,542 were struck by on-track equipment
- 262 slipped, fell, stumbled

Trespasser Casualties: Physical Activity and Event 2011- 2014

- 3,404 total events
- 1015 – Walking – struck by equipment
- 388 - Laying – struck by equipment
- 244 – Standing – struck by equipment
- 203 – Sitting – struck by equipment
- 90 – Running – struck by equipment
- 83 – Walking – slipped, fell, stumbled

2014 Trespass Casualties By Location

- 945 total events
- 143 besides tracks
- 119 between tracks (e.g., double tracks)
- 529 on track
- 1 in tunnel
- 40 on bridge/trestle
- 113 - other
