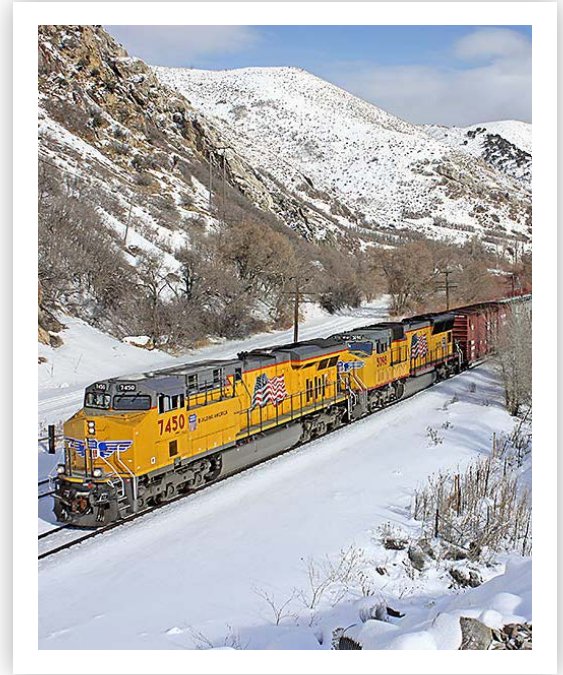

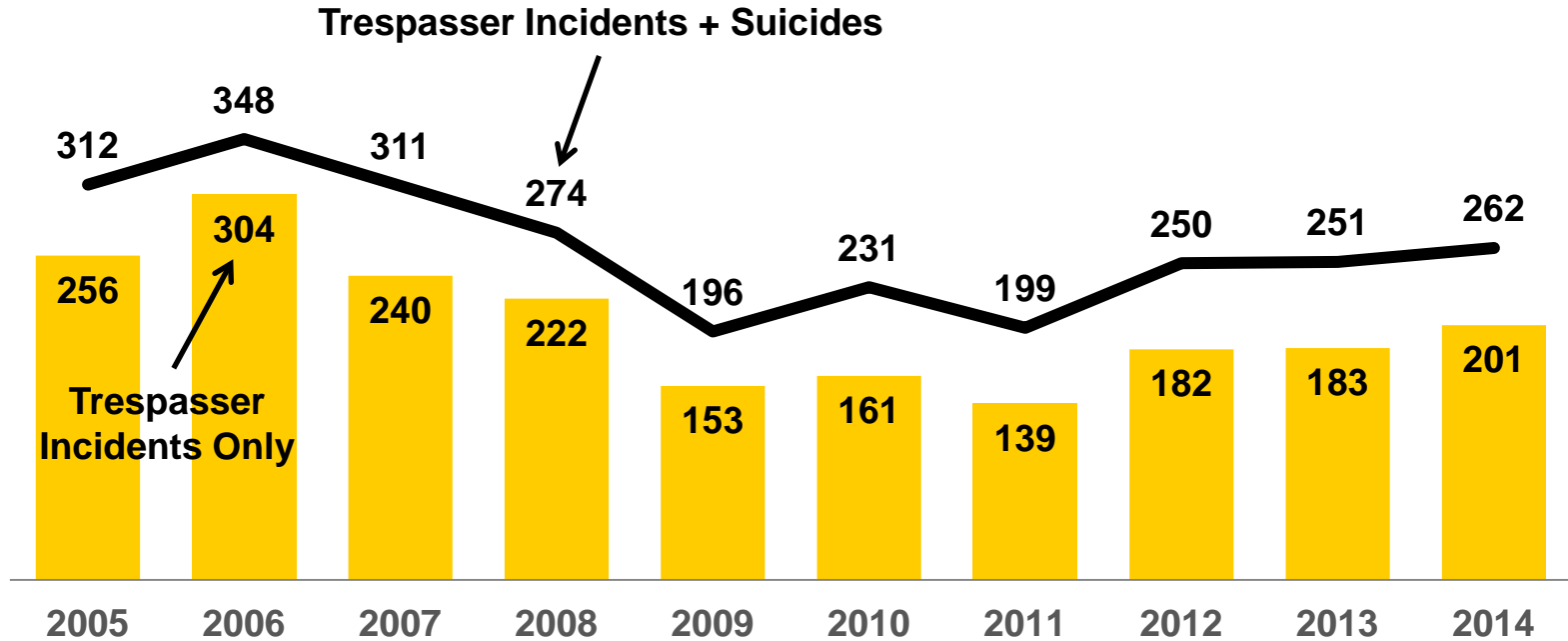
# Trespasser Incidents Defined



- Trespassers: Persons who are on the part of railroad property used in railroad operation and whose presence is prohibited, forbidden, or unlawful.
- Trespasser Incidents do not include:
  - Incidents at grade crossings
  - Suicides or attempted suicides confirmed by 3<sup>rd</sup> party coroner, public police officer or other public authority

# Trespasser Incident Process



- Notify Response Management Communication Center (RMCC)
  - 911
  - Dispatch railroad personnel
- Train and scene is secured
- Crew relieved of duty & provided support
  - Peer support
  - Employee assistance program
- Train traffic is stopped for investigation
- Notifications are made
- Train traffic is resumed
