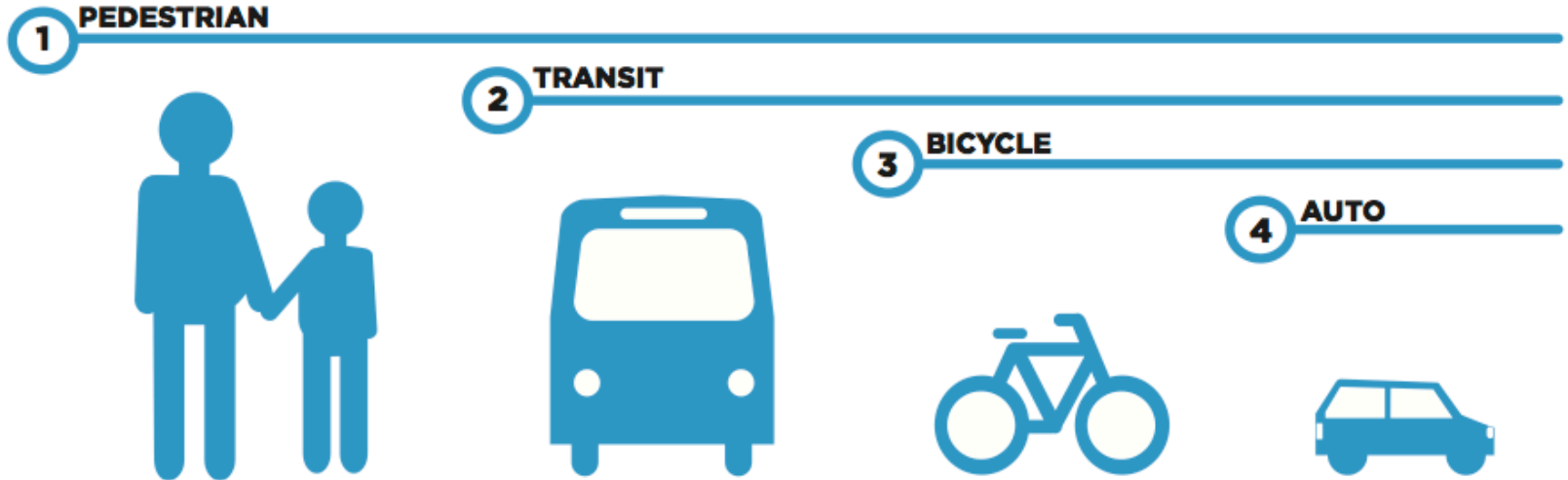

Safety principles

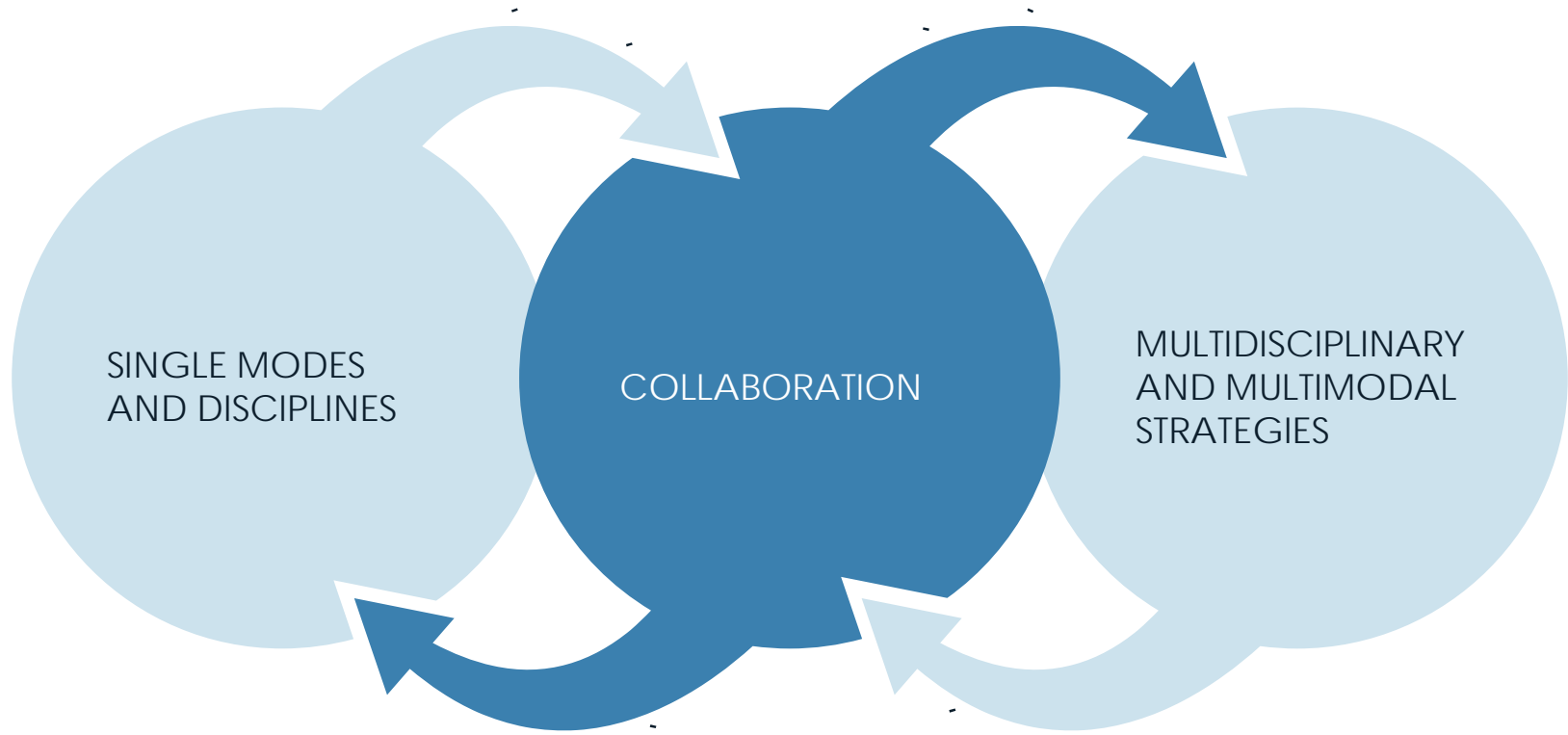
- (1) Reduce crash rates and severity;**

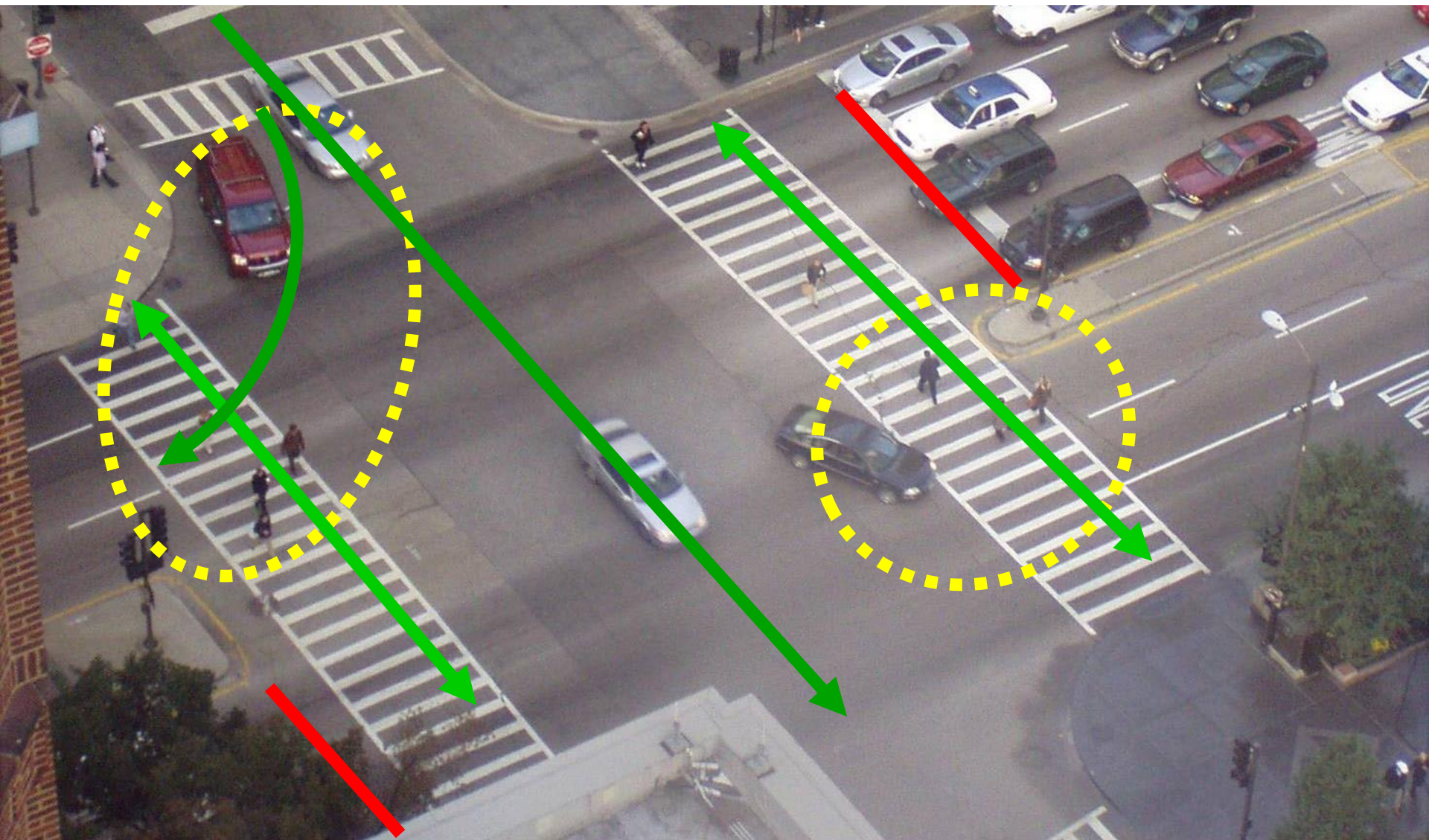

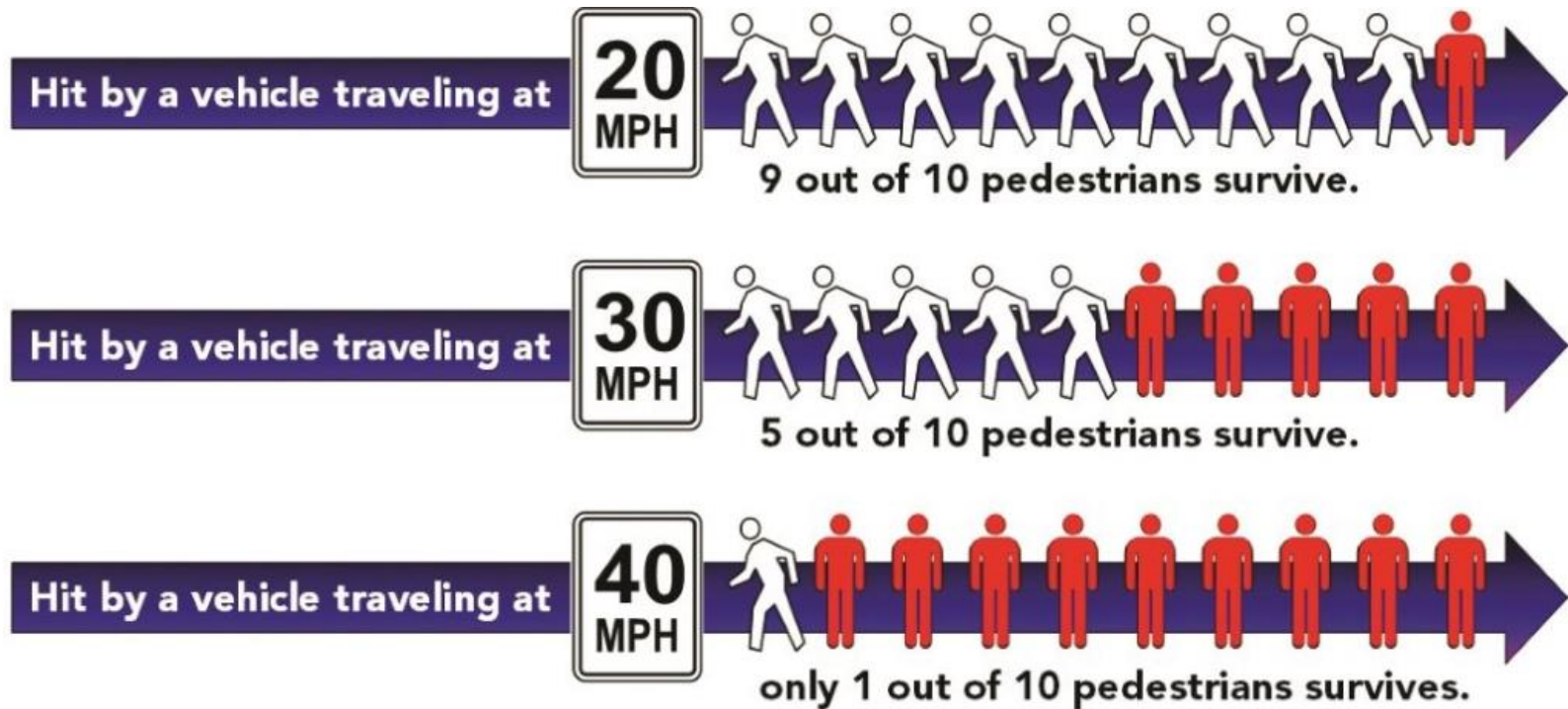
