Medical Conditions

- Chronic pain

 Tibromyalgia

 Type II diabetes

 High blood pressure

 High cholesterol
- Alcohol dependence
- Attention deficit
 hyperactivity disorder
 (ADHD)
- Depression

Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)

- Deficits in attention and susceptibility to distraction
- Pilot status: ADHD not well controlled

Depression

- Depressed mood, loss of interest or pleasure, impaired thinking, concentrating, decision-making
 - Persistent cognitive symptoms after treatment
- Pilot status: depression not well controlled
 - 3 months before accident
 - Symptomatic
 - Medications restarted; no additional information

Medications

- Prescribed 13 medications
 Many likely not impairing
- Toxicology: 5 likely impairing medications
 - Three prescription
 - Cyclobenzaprine, diazepam, oxycodone
 - Two over-the-counter
 - Dextromethorphan, diphenhydramine

Drug Interactions and Information

- Combination magnifies impairing psychoactive effects
- FAA resources
 - "Do Not Issue Do Not Fly" lists
 - "Unaware of impair"

Pilot Impairment

- Effect on decision-making
 - Depression
 - Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder
 - Combined effects of multiple central nervous system-impairing drugs

FAA Medical Certification

- Not held by pilot
- Certification exam
 - Comprehensive pilot history of medical conditions
 - Medication use
 - Examination by an aviation medical examiner
- NDR check

Balloon Pilot Exemption

- Commercial pilots medical certification exemption: 14 CFR 61.23(a)(b)
- Eliminated opportunity to identify issues
 - AME evaluation of conditions and medications
 - FAA awareness of drug and alcohol offenses
