## Safety Recommendation

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The National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB) is an independent federal agency charged by Congress with investigating every civil aviation accident in the United States and significant accidents in other modes of transportation—railroad, highway, marine, and pipeline. We determine the probable cause of the accidents and issue safety recommendations aimed at preventing future accidents. In addition, we carry out special studies concerning transportation safety and coordinate the resources of the federal government and other organizations to provide assistance to victims and their family members affected by major transportation disasters. We are providing the following information to urge Boh Bros. Construction Co. to take action on the safety recommendation being issued in this letter.

On September 22, 2015, we adopted our report concerning the August 13, 2014, accident in which the *Cory Michael* tow allided with the Florida Avenue Bridge.<sup>1</sup> Additional information about this accident and the resulting recommendations may be found in the report of the investigation, which can be accessed at our website, [www.nts.gov](http://www.nts.gov), under report number MAR-15/02.

As a result of this investigation, we issued five new recommendations, including one to Boh Bros. Construction Co., one to the Port of New Orleans, two to the US Coast Guard, and the following recommendation to the Occupational Safety and Health Administration:

### M-15-12

Revise existing regulations at Title 29 *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 1910 to address the placement and securing of crane booms on barges for transit to and from marine construction and other sites.

Chairman HART, Vice Chairman DINH-ZARR, and Members SUMWALT and WEENER concurred in this recommendation.
